School Lottery

We are so excited to announce our first School lottery. Tickets will be sold per academic year (£1 per month, paid in one go, in advance). You will be allocated a number per entry and keep that number for the year. Your number or numbers then get entered into the draw for every month of that academic year. As we are starting in January, the cost of this years lottery tickets starting in January will be £8. We will draw the last tickets for this year in July & pay out for both July & August before the summer holidays. We will then start again in September with a 12 month draw.

Each month there will be a cash prize of 50% of the monthly profit. For example if 50 people join for January, £25 will be the prize money for that month. The more people join, the more the prize money goes up. Once we reach £60 prize money per month, we will split the prize to make it as fair as possible for all to have a chance to win. We will always let you know what the prize amounts will be and winners will always be announced in the weekly news.



Easy Fundraising


