

# OUR LEARNING PLAN

## JUNIPER CLASS

### LITERACY

The first half of our summer term writing will be based on Ancient Egypt. The children will be writing about the life of Tutankhamun in addition to creating an advert to convince people to visit Egypt or Rome. The children's focus will be on composition of their writing with a detailed look at sentence types: commands, statements, questions or explanations and the corresponding punctuation. Similarly, we will look carefully at writing in different tenses and how our writing may have to change if we are talking about something singular or plural.

### PE

This term, Juniper class will be focusing on Rounders and Athletics. The children will develop their teamwork skills, throwing, catching, striking and fielding skills. In Athletics they will prepare themselves for Sports Day.

### THEMATIC CURRICULUM

Ancient Buildings is our overarching theme for our afternoon learning. We will look at various times historical periods and learn about their famous buildings: this will include the Ancient Egyptian Pyramids, The Colosseum of Rome and a local comparison of Framlingham Castle. The children will create their own versions of the buildings and understand their uses and what it was like to live during that time. Our science learning will be linked as we learn about materials

### MATHS

This term, Juniper class start their mathematical learning focusing on data handling. We will explore pictograms and bar charts; we will create our own from data that we collect from around the school as well as interpreting the data shown in various charts. The children will be able to identify from our data presentations which is the highest value, which is the lowest, and answer further questions from the graphs and charts that they study. Our learning will continue onto the topic of money, where the children will work practically to pay for things in the class and use their understanding of the four operations to answer calculations involving money.

### PSHE

The focus of our PSHE learning this term is 'Friendships and Relationships'. Our learning will focus on team work, what makes a good friend, and what a 'good' relationship is. Alongside this, the pupils in Year 5 and 6 will be learning about the changes that our body will go through as we get older and the correct naming of specific body parts.
