## WILLOW CLASS

### LITERACY

We will be focusing on two different texts - Where the River takes us by Lesley Parr and The River by Valerie Bloom - we will be creating pieces of writing based on Narratives, Poems, Explanations and Non-Chronological Reports

### MATHS

We have a busy term ahead in Maths where we will focus on Time, Money, Shape and Statistics - a wide range of topics this term!

### SCIENCE
