



## From 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017 the Government are doubling the amount of free Childcare from 15 to 30 hours

ALL three and four year olds are already entitled to 15 hours a week of free childcare but if eligible this can be extended to 30 hrs for your child but it depends on your working income, e.g. if you earn at least the equivalent of 16 hours a week at National Minimum or Living Wage.

## How to find out if my family can get the additional 15 hours?

- Visit the government's www.childcarechoices.gov.uk website.
- If successful you will get a code (number)
- Please give this code to your school, with your child's birth certificate & proof of address

For children who turn 3 between	the free childcare starts from
1 April to 31 August	September (Autumn Term)
1 <sup>st</sup> Sept to 31 December	January (Spring Term)
1 <sup>st</sup> January – 31 March	April (Summer Term)

## TAX FREE CHILDCARE

This is a separate scheme to the '30 hours free childcare' and is available to help with the cost of childcare, enabling more parents to go out to work, if they wish to.

This service has been gradually rolled out from April and will be available for under fours from 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017, (but is also available to parents with children under 12 years)

To check your eligibility & register visit <u>www.childcarechoices.gov.uk</u> (which is the same website as the 30 hours free childcare)

Ten things to know about Tax-Free Childcare :-

- You will be able to open an online account, which you can pay into to cover the cost of childcare with a registered provider
- For every 80p paid in the government will top up an extra 20p
- The scheme will be available for children under age of 12
- To qualify parents will have to be in work, and each earning at least £120 a week and not more than £100,000 each per year
- Any eligible working family can use the Tax-Free Childcare Scheme it does not rely on employers offering it
- The scheme will be available for parents who are self-employed
- If you currently receive Employer-Supported Childcare then you can continue to do so
- Parents and others can pay money into their childcare account as and when they like
- The process will be as simple as possible for parents
- You will be able to withdraw money from the account if you want to
